Job Overview

Riverland Family Farms is looking for reliable and personable team members to help bring farm's produce to the community and help with farm operations. This role focuses on **farmers' market operations**, including transporting produce, setting up and breaking down market booths, and providing excellent customer service—as well as **on-farm support** in a variety of roles as needed. The right candidate is punctual, flexible, enjoys hands-on work, and takes pride in representing the farm in public.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist with daily farm operations including planting, harvesting, irrigation, and maintenance of crops and facilities. Responsibilities include operating basic farm equipment, maintaining a clean and organized work environment, and supporting farm operations as needed: harvesting, washing, packing, labeling, and organizing inventory.
- Manage and operate farm stands at local farmers markets: transport, assist in setting up tents and booths, display produce, handle sales, break down booths, load delivery truck, and transport back to the farm.
- Safely drive and operate a delivery truck to transport produce to markets, wholesale customers, and other outlets (*within 70 miles radius from Corvallis, OR*).
- Handle, load, and unload produce with care to maintain quality standards.
- Represent the farm with professionalism, friendliness, and excellent customer service.
- Work long days on Saturdays and additional hours during the week as needed, totaling **15 – 40 hrs per week**.

Qualifications

- Clean driving record and valid driver's license; experience with box trucks or large vans required.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills; enjoys engaging with customers.
- Reliable, punctual, and able to work independently or as part of a team.
- Comfortable with physical labor, lifting to 50 lbs., and working outdoors in varying conditions. Ideal candidates are reliable, physically fit, and able to work outdoors in varying weather conditions.
- Availability to work long hours over the weekends (Saturday) and early mornings.
